Donations for Fort Leonard Wood Tornado Victims

The USO is the Tornado Relief Operations Center for providing relief to the victims of the tornado. The USO mobile is there providing refreshments to the relief workers. The USO is collecting/distributing all donated items, etc. for the relief workers and families searching through their homes after the Tornado.

The USO is providing items and accepting donations from 9 a.m. - 6 p.m. seven days a week until further notice. They are also in need of volunteers from 2 - 6 pm daily until further notice. For more information call 573-329-2039. All items and cash/check donations can be delivered to the FLW USO. To get to the USO, enter main gate and don't turn anywhere until you get to a T-intersection. Turn right and go to next stop sign, turn right and the USO is about a block down on the right side.

If you are unable to deliver your donations to the USO you can drop them off at the Waynesville-St. Robert Chamber office at 137 St. Robert Blvd., Ste. B and we will deliver them for you.

While the USO is taking care of the physical needs, Army Community Services (ACS) is taking care of the cash/check donations. Checks can be made out to Army Community Services and note in the check or letter that funds are only for the Tornado Victims Fund. All money/checks go for food vouchers and other vouchers, gift cards, good at the commissary/grocery stores, etc. Money will also go for items not donated.

Membership is now up to thirty four paid up for 2011 out of forty six. We are slowly getting close to one hundred percent.

This months Promenade will be on January 26th in Cameron, MO with dinner and Promenade at Post 33. Dinner – provided by Post 33 Auxiliary will begin at 18:00 HRS with the Promenade beginning at 19:00 HRS.
